
“EUGLOH 2021” Call for Projects

Presentation

EUGLOH, a European University for training future generations both on global health - a cohesive topic embracing several fields and responding to crucial societal challenges - and on European values and citizenship.

EUGLOH, it is 5 universities (*Université Paris-Saclay, University of Porto, Szeged University, LMU University, Lund University*) sharing the ambition of combining their expertise and resources in Global Health to offer the best education and training to their students. Fostering mobility experience (be it physical or virtual) to 50% of its students of all levels (Bachelor, Master, PhD alike), studying in all fields related to Global Health.

- Students of all levels, disciplines and profiles: initial of activities and life-long learning and training.
- Academic staff: teach, initiate new programmes with the partners, open up to new viewpoints and new skills, transfer expertise and competencies ...
- Support staff: exchange best practices, training, information, advice

EUGLOH is a pilot university, not only innovative, but also fully conscious of its responsibilities and ready to face societal challenges, in particular those related to Global Health.

- Training students as future leaders, both as experts in their fields and responsible citizens: curious, creative, and adaptable to diverse ecosystems and cultural environments.
- A collaboration framework open to contributions from all players and all fields concerned by Global Health (medicine and law, engineering, and sports...) on the long run, strive towards a joint European degree as well as a joint campus life.
- Creating a multicultural, integrated and inclusive campus for the benefit of all students and staff.
- Foster links between higher education, research and the local socio-enhance knowledge and skills related to Global Health (Webinars and videoconferences, Conferences, workshops and seasonal schools).

Within this alliance, the Université Paris-Saclay brings together 14 higher education and research institutions, pooling quality teaching and research at the highest international level to meet the challenge



of global competition in teaching, research and innovation but also seeking for an innovative and inclusive campus.

The Université Paris-Saclay wishes to strengthen ties between its communities and develop a sense of belonging to the EUGLOH community, while increasing its influence on the international stage, where everyone can feel welcomed and at home.

In the framework of the alliance, *MESRI (Ministère Français de l'Enseignement Supérieur, de la Recherche et de l'Innovation)* - *SGPI (Secrétariat général pour l'investissement)* - *ANR (Agence National de Recherche)* supports transnational projects to finance students and staff initiatives that participate to the strengthening and reinforcing integration of EUGLOH campus life amongst its partners' campuses.

Projects we are looking for

- Projects may be varied in nature (*e.g. a cultural, social, scientific, sporting, entrepreneurial, or one-off event*), and may be carried out individually or in a group.
- Mandatory: collaboration with at least one other EUGLOH partner
- Addressing one or several of EUGLOH campus life focuses :
 - o Ease mobility
 - o Language & intercultural skills
 - o Social & cultural activities
 - o Diversity, inclusion and well-being
- In compliance with EUGLOH campus life social & cultural identity and ethics (*cf annexe*)

Examples of topics and means

- Women in science, Science communication & performing arts, open education, sports competitions
- ...
- Series of podcasts or short instructive videos, ...

What's in it for you?

- Financial support: a grant of up to €4,000
- Support to link with EUGLOH alliance partners
- Assistance in developing your communication strategy



- Increased visibility among the EUGLOH community, particularly via the website and social network pages (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn)
- The dissemination of your communication activities
- In addition to the financial support, possibility of short mobility on one or several of the 5 EUGLOH campuses if sanitary measures allows it (*upon proposal's needs_ in the limit of 5 mobility of 5 days per call*)

Conditions

Projects must meet the following criteria:

- The designated project leader must be a student or employee of a Université Paris-Saclay member institution while time of implementation of the initiative. This person will be the interlocutor who reports to the Université Paris-Saclay on the progress of the project, the use of the grant funding, and provides the final report comprising the activity report, the financial balance sheet of the project and a communication file.
- The project must be led with collaboration of a minimum of one of EUGLOH partner's student, employee, or non-profit/student organisation
- It should not give rise to a commercial activity.
- The project funded should not be a tutored project forming part of a course of study.
- The project must be implemented **before March 1st 2022**, with all project expenditure incurred before that date.
- Project may be co-funded if there is obvious benefit for EUGLOH community and respect of EUGLOH ethical positions as well as no conflict of interest.

Selection criteria

- Display of Université Paris-Saclay and EUGLOH : in particular, the EUGLOH and Université Paris-Saclay logo must appear prominently among the main sponsors
- International openness
- European added value
- Visibility of the event or project
- Visibility of the participation of the project leader(s) and involvement of EUGLOH partners
- Proposed communication plan
- Innovative nature
- Should address one of the following thematic: *well-being, interculturality, Diversity & inclusion, social & cultural*



Expenditure eligible for a grant of up to €4,000

All expenditure falling within the ANR PIA financial regulations is eligible, subject to the following conditions:

The grant funding payments provided by ANR PIA 3 EUGLOH CONVENTION ATTRIBUTIVE D'AIDE n° ANR-19-GURE-0006

- expenditure should not exceed €4,000 (*the maximum amount potentially allocated to a project under this scheme*)
- Université Paris-Saclay DRIE department will directly pay the suppliers used for implementation of the awarded projects

Schedule

- Launch of the call for projects: 19th April 2021
- Closing date for applications: 30th May 2021 midnight
- Early June: selection of projects by the selection committee
- 1st March 2022: deadline for total expenditure
- + 60 days: deadline for sending the project report

Application form

- Project title
- Location and starting and ending date of implementation of project
- Presentation of the project leader(s) & EUGLOH partners (or profiles needed)
- Detailed presentation of the project and its actions
 - o Project objectives
 - o Target audience (what audience? what attendance?)
 - o Impact / visibility
 - o Is this a new project or a follow-up to previous editions? If the project is part of a recurring event/activity, provide details from the report from previous editions.
- Estimated budget with financing details
- Provisional project implementation schedule
- Communication plan
- Additional documentation if necessary
