

"My Campus with Thousand Faces"

Rules of Contest

1. THEME: Capture moments of tranquillity and relaxation on campus.

1.1 Objectives pursued

Organisation of a joint photography competition on the topic "My Campus with Thousand Faces", the best entries will be announced in December.

To improve the photography and artistic skills of the participants, promoting the importance of an intercultural community, enhancing the importance and visibility of different creative ideas, cultures and identities.

1.2 Expected results

increased attention to the existence and functioning of EUGLOH project
increased visibility of EUGLOH social media channels
valorisation of the Campus life and community
valorisation of the students' involvement in the Campus life
ability to express one's vision and creativity
development of artistic & creative skills

2. PRIZE

Winners of the photo contest will receive the chance to travel to Hungary, Szeged to participate in a photo course. Travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the EUGLOH WP5 campus life budget.

3. DEADLINES & ADMISSIBILITY

Deadlines	
Opening of contest	10 th of October 2023
Deadline for submission	10 th of December 2023

To participate, contestants need to submit a photo representing their own perception of their University campus. To enter the contest, participants must fill out a registration form in which – along with other data - they upload the photo.

Participants must only upload a photo that represents their own intellectual property. In case the photo features any persons, or data belonging to other persons, their preliminary consent is necessary. Each participant may register the contest with only one photo.

The picture composition is free and can be reused by EUGLOH and the nine member universities. If anyone is to appear on it, image authorisation should be cleared.

By submitting their work, participants agree to the terms and conditions of participation below.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Eligibility criteria

Participants of the EUGLOH photo contest must meet the following eligibility criteria to participate:

- 1. Be a legal person over 18 years old. No group submissions accepted, contestant must be an individual person.
- 2. Be a student at one of the 9 EUGLOH partner universities at the time of the contest: (Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München (LMU Munich), Lund University (LU), UiT The Arctic University of Norway (UiT), Universität Hamburg (UHH), Université Paris-Saclay (UPSaclay), University of Alcalá (UAH), University of Novi Sad (UNS), University of Porto (UPorto), University of Szeged (USZ).
- 3. Each participant may participate in the contest with one photo only.

4.2 Exclusion criteria

Participants will be excluded if they (or one of them):

- are subject to an administrative sanction (i.e. exclusion)¹
- are in one of the following situations²:
 - publication of irrelevant, disrespectful or disturbing content
 - the participants do not correspond to the abovementioned eligibility criteria

- bankrupt, being wound up, having their affairs administered by the courts, entered into an arrangement with creditors, suspended business activities or subject to any other similar proceedings or procedures under national law (including persons with unlimited liability for the participant's debts)
- declared in breach of social security or tax obligations by a final judgment or decision (including persons with unlimited liability for the participant's debts)
- found guilty of grave professional misconduct³ by a final judgment or decision (including persons having powers of representation, decision-making or control)
- convicted of fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organisation, money laundering, terrorism-related crimes (including terrorism financing), child labour or human trafficking (including persons having powers of representation, decision-making or control)
- shown significant deficiencies in complying with main obligations under a procurement contract, grant agreement or grant decision financed by the EU or Euratom budget (including persons having powers of representation, decisionmaking or control)
- found guilty of irregularities within the meaning of Article 1(2) of Regulation No 2988/95 (including persons having powers of representation, decision-making or control)
- have misrepresented information required for participating in the contest or fail to submit such information
- were involved in the preparation of the prize documents and this entails a distortion of competition.

5. AWARD CRITERIA

An unbiased jury consisting of members of the EUGLOH Alliance or/and experts assigned by the partner universities will choose the winners of the photo contest. The jury will consist of members who are not affiliated with the participants and did not take part in the contest. The jury will be shown all the eligible photos without mentioning the author's name or institution. In order to identify the pictures, each of them will have a number. Each jury member will vote on their own favourite photos without consulting with the other members. When the voting is complete, the number of votes will be counted. The 3 photos with the most votes will be chosen and announced as the winners of the competition.

Professional misconduct includes: violation of ethical standards of the profession, wrongful conduct with impact on professional credibility, false

6. PROCEDURE, CHECKING ELIGIBILITY, DOCUMENTS

The EUGLOH team will regularly check the submitted photos and reach out to participants to acquire personal data to validate the eligibility of the contestants. In case the participants – for any reason - fail to present their data by the time of the jury vote, their works will not be eligible for jury voting. Any photos submitted after the participation deadline will not be eligible for the jury voting.

Contestants should note that they might be asked at a later stage for further documents (for legal entity validation, bank account validation, ethics review, declaration of honour on exclusion grounds, etc).

7. OTHER CONDITIONS

- Participation in our photo competition voluntary and at your own responsibility.
- By submitting a photo you assure that you are the owner of the photo and that the photo does not violate any rights of third parties.
- Only those can win the competition who are students of one of the 9 EUGLOH member Universities at the time of the photo submission.
- In case of winning, you accept our privacy policy regarding the conduct of the photo competition and the administration of your submitted photo.
- In the case of winning the contest, you grant EUGLOH permission stating your name if you so desire to publish the photo and its description free of charge, to reproduce it and to use and distribute it for EUGLOH's public relations work for an unlimited period of time. This permission also applies to the use of the material in exhibitions, printed works, electronic media, film and on the internet.
- By submitting the material, you assure that you have received a declaration of consent from clearly recognizable persons both for the recording as such and for the use of the material for participation in the EUGLOH photo competition.
- If it turns out that
 - a) you are not the copyright holder of the photo,
 - b) rights of third parties are violated or
 - c) a clearly recognizable person has not given a corresponding declaration of consent, EUGLOH is not responsible to third parties, but you as the photo submitter. EUGLOH is entitled to reclaim the award or prize from the winners if it turns out afterwards that one of the cases (a), b), c)) mentioned above is given.

7.1 Payment arrangements

Travelling and accommodation costs will be covered through the EUGLOH WP5 campus life budget of the winners' university.

7.2 Publicity — Promoting the Results of the Contest — Visibility of EU funding

EUGLOH may use, for its communication and publicising activities, information relating to the action, documents notably summaries for publication as well as any other material, such as pictures or audio-visual material that it receives from the participants (including in electronic form).

EUGLOH will publish the name of the winner(s), their university of origin, and their reward—unless they have requested to waive this publication (because disclosure risks threatening its security and safety or harm its commercial interest).

7.3 Processing of personal data

7.3.1 Processing of personal data by EUGLOH

Any personal data will be processed by EUGLOH in respect to the GDPR and data processing.

All participants consent that EUGLOH publishes the following information:

- name
- University of origin
- contest reward
- photo submitted to the competition

in whatever form and medium.

7.3.2 Processing of personal data by the participants

The participants must process personal data in compliance with applicable EU and national law on data protection (including authorisations or notification requirements, if any).

7.4 Ethics

The activities must be carried out in compliance with:

- (a) ethical principles and
- (b) applicable international, EU and national law.

7.5 Conflict of interests

The participants must take all measures to prevent any situation where the impartial and objective award of the prize is compromised for reasons involving economic interest, political or national affinity, family or emotional ties or any other shared interest ('conflict of interests').

They must inform EUGLOH without delay of any situation constituting or likely to lead to a conflict of interests and immediately take all the necessary steps to rectify this situation.

7.6 Liability for damages

EUGLOH or the member universities cannot be held liable for any damage caused to the participants or to third parties as a consequence of the reward, including for gross negligence.

EUGLOH or the member universities cannot be held liable for any damage caused by any of the participants in the context of the context reward.

7.7 Checks, audits and investigation

EUGLOH photo contest prizes and-or rewards are being funded by the European Commission, the Agency or the Commission, the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) and the European Court of Auditors may carry out checks, audits and investigations in relation to the prize.

7.8 Withdrawal of the prize — Recovery of undue amounts

EUGLOH may withdraw the prize after its award and recover all payments made, if it finds out that:

- (a) false information, fraud or corruption was used to obtain it
- (b) a winner was not eligible or should have been excluded
- (c) a winner is in serious breach of its obligations under these Rules of Contest.

7.9 Administrative sanctions

If a participant has committed irregularities or fraud or has made false declarations, the European Commission may also:

(d) exclude the participant from all future contracts, grants and contests financed from the EU or Euratom budget for a maximum of five years (or 10 years in case of repetition)

and/or

7.10 Cancellation of the contest

EUGLOH may cancel the contest or decide not to award the prize — without any obligation to compensate participants —, if:

- (e) no applications are received
- (f) the winner is not eligible or must be excluded or
- (g) the objective of the contest has already been achieved.

7.11 Complaints

Complaints against decisions negatively affecting the rights of a participant or winner can be brought before the General Court — or, on appeal, the Court of Justice of the European Union — under Article 263 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the EU (TFEU).
